## Wait for "NRDS" ID

Your NRDS (National Realtor Database System) ID is a 9 digit number that is provided by the National Association of Realtors (NAR) and is the key to open the door to member benefits including access to the Multiple Listing Service (MLS). You will receive an email from the LARA CEO with your NRDS number.



TIP: Make sure email "denise@lakesrealtors.com" is safe to avoid having the email end up in junk or spam folders.

## **Complete New Member Orientation**

All new members are required to take an orientation class and complete NAR's online Code of Ethics class within 100 days of joining LARA. Details are included in the Welcome email.
